	<p>BUDDY SYSTEM:</p> <p>Your buddy from AIA Student Club will contact you in middle of January, and they will help you with registration procedures upon your arrival on orientation day February 12th.</p>
<p>VISA</p> <p>&</p> <p>ARC</p>	<p>Please visit Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs for visa application. Students are strongly recommended to apply for a visa in order to study with us!</p> <p>Website: http://www.boca.gov.tw/</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa free (students from certain countries can enter Taiwan Visa free for 30- 90 days per entry and no extension available. Therefore, it is best if students could apply for a visa. ■ Visitor's visa: For those who will stay in Taiwan for no more than 6 months, extension available in Taiwan. ■ Resident Visas: For those who will study in Taiwan for more than 6 months, extension available in Taiwan. <p>Alien Resident Certificate (ARC): For those who will study in Taiwan for <u>more than 6 months</u>. Students need to apply for ARC within 15 days from the day after arrival, fail to apply within 15 days will lead to a fine as punishment. 	<p>Medical insurance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ (Option 1): All incoming exchange students must have medical insurance covering the duration of stay in Taiwan. You may buy a health insurance in your home country. ■ (Option 2): Exchange student could buy the Cathay Life Insurance on campus after arrival. (NT 3,000 per semester)
 <p>Courses</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ <u>There are several stages for students to select courses, you shall first select courses in your department/ your level, then allowed to select course in different departments, different level. Detailed information to be announced by our Academic Affairs Office on the document of course selection regulation.</u> ★ Course selection (pre-selection & during first 2 weeks courses): Students could change classes on arrival during the first 2 weeks via online course selection system. ★ Course pre-selection (before arrival): around 20th of December, 2019 via Exchange Student information system (click here for link, password of the system will be posted on Exchange Application System by December 17th). Don't miss it!! <p>Mandarin Class: Registration starts on arrival. 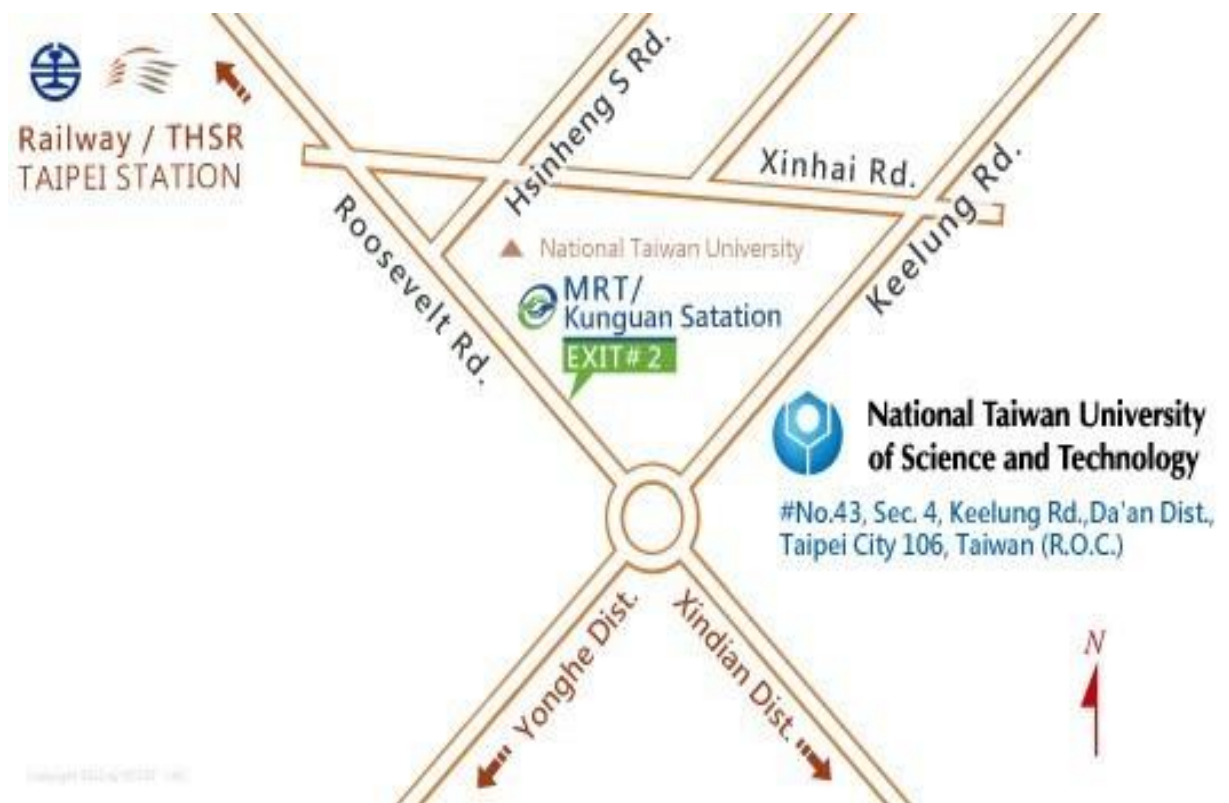
Please take the airport MRT express train to Taipei Main Station, then change to Taipei Metro.

■ Taipei Metro: Transportation from Taipei Main Station (Red line R10) to Gongguan station (Green line G07):

Step 1: Take Red line first from Taipei Main Station (Red line R10) for two stops to Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall (R08, G10).

Step 2: At Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall (R08, G10), change platform to Green line and take 3 stops to Gong-guan station Exit 2 (Green line G07).
